

ABOUT THE POSITION: The Latino Community Foundation (LCF) seeks a dedicated Grants and Philanthropy Associate to join our team during an exciting time of growth in our grantmaking and donor engagement work. The Grants and Philanthropy Associate will strengthen LCF's grantmaking and philanthropic efforts by supporting accurate recordkeeping in our grants and philanthropy database. The Grants and Philanthropy Associate will be responsible for the data entry of donations to LCF and grant awards made by LCF to community partners. They will be an instrumental team member for our philanthropy team, supporting donor stewardship and ensuring that our donors receive written acknowledgment for their support. They will also be a first point of contact for incoming calls to the Foundation from across diverse groups of people and sectors.

The Grants and Philanthropy Associate will report to LCF's Vice President of Philanthropy. They will be a data and detail-oriented team member who brings positive energy and a can-do attitude to enhance LCF's grantmaking and philanthropic processes. The Grants and Philanthropy Associate will also support the Grantmaking and Special Projects Director in building and elevating LCF's relationships with community partners and our Latino nonprofit leaders.

Key Responsibilities

I. Grants and Philanthropy Database Support

- Record incoming gifts and donor information, ensuring documents and relevant information are stored in our database.
- Collaborate regularly with LCF's Finance team and Latino Giving Circle Network team to ensure timely reconciliation of donations to the Foundation.
- Manage contributions from various donation portals.
- Work with Grants and Philanthropy Manager on updating contribution data from previous years.

II. Grantmaking Support

- Work with Grantmaking team to prepare grant awards, complete due diligence, and generate grant documents and correspondence.
- Communicate with LCF community partners (grantees) on various matters.
- Assist team with quarterly Board reports on grantmaking.

III. Relationship Building

- Serve as a welcoming, first point of contact for phone inquiries to the Foundation.
- Support donor stewardship activities, including the generation of gift acknowledgment letters.
- Expand LCF's Latino Power Map to ensure current and new organizational data is updated.
- Strengthen and support relationships with community partners, Latino nonprofit leaders, and donors.

Preferred Qualifications, Skills, and Attributes

LCF seeks a collaborative professional who pays strong attention to detail. The ideal candidate will have 2+ years of experience in data entry, grantmaking support, and/or fundraising experience. Experience working with the Salesforce platform is a plus. Experience in philanthropic or nonprofit organizations is also a plus.

- Excellent written, verbal, and interpersonal communication skills.
- Process and detail oriented.
- Strong alignment with LCF's mission and values.
- Energetic, fun, flexible, and proactive.
